At a recent site meeting Swansea Council pointed out that the slope a disabled ramp needed to be modified. In order to ascertain the cost of this, test bore holes need to be made.

RECOMMEND that MCC cover the cost of the test bore holes.

CS.20.008 Skate Park – Update

Awaiting confirmation from Swansea Council of their requirements for asset transfer.
